Directions

Initial Application

1. Remove existing floor finish with appropriate SSS Floor Finish Stripper.
2. Rinse floor thoroughly and allow to dry.
3. Using a clean SSS Finish Mop, apply a thin, uniform coat of finish. Allow to dry thoroughly (30 - 40 minutes). Apply additional coats in the same manner and let dry. For very porous floors, an initial coat of floor sealer is recommended.

Day-to-Day Maintenance

1. Sweep or dust mop as necessary.
2. Damp mop with SSS Straightaway Neutral Floor Cleaner or SSS Trifecta Enzyme Floor Cleaner following label directions. For accumulated soil, lightly scrub as required.
3. To repair finish, use SSS Turnaround Spray Buff or SSS Champion Floor Finish Restorer with a buffing pad or apply another coat of finish (see Step 3 above).
